Eligible Artwork: Members are invited to submit up to three works created within the last five years. All flat works must be ready to hang. Entrants must become DMA members or have a valid membership at the time of show. Membership information can be found at www.danforthmuseum.org or by calling 508 620-0050 x14.

Application Process: The Danforth Museum of Art requires a \$10.00 handling fee per submission. For each submission, fill out BOTH sides of the form below (you may make copies). Attach one side to the back of your work and submit the other side at the time of registration. Please deliver artwork(s) to the Museum from

Wednesday, April 23 – Sunday, April 27, 10am – 4pm
and Wednesday, April 30 – Saturday, May 3, 10am – 4pm
Late submissions will not be accepted.

Please Note: The Danforth Museum of Art will exercise the utmost care in the handling of the works submitted. However, the Museum will assume no responsibility for damaged or lost artwork.

Jurying Process: Carole Anne Meehan, Curator at the Institute of Contemporary Art/Boston, will jury this exhibition, and will award first, second, third and honorable mention prizes. Entrants will be notified by e-mail of the status of their work. Please do not call the Museum.

The Show: The Members' Show will be held from Saturday, May 31 – Sunday, August 3, 2008. The Museum will host an opening reception for the show on Saturday, May 31, from 6 – 8pm.

Carole Anne Meehan, Curator at the Institute of Contemporary Art/Boston, joined the ICA's staff in 1998 as the first director of ICA/Vita Brevis, a program that commissioned public art in response to

Boston's landscape and history. Through this effort twenty-six new works of art were presented in a range of public sites, including four in 2007's Art on the Harbor Islands, selected for an award by the International Association of Art Critics. Meehan also directs the James and Audrey Foster Prize exhibition and award program for Boston area artists of exceptional artistic promise. Sales: Artwork for sale must be priced by the artist (40% of the sale price will benefit the Museum). Purchases may be made by cash, check, MC/Visa, AmEx, or Discover. Shortly after the close of the exhibition, artists will be mailed checks for works sold.

Tuesday – Wednesday, September 2 & 3, 10 am – 4 pm
After September 28, 2008, the work will be considered property of the Museum.
