- 18x24" white drawing pad
- Pencils
- Eraser

Fashion Illustration (Class or Workshop)

Materials:

- 9" x 12" pad of Bristol paper
- Package of at least 12 colored markers (more colors if possible)
- Package of at least 12 colors of watercolor/water-soluble colored pencils (more colors if possible)
- Ultra-fine-point black marker
- Small round brush with pointed tip
- Pencil, eraser, scissors, glue stick
- 1 fashion magazine to cut up for collage, 1 fashion magazine to look at for inspiration
